Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence IVB

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence IVB engine test. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. This engine test should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM Sequence IVB Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence IVB engine test stands were calibrated on October 18, 2018. Therefore, PAPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the Sequence IVB through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Retroactive registration will be accepted through the ACC Monitoring Agency according to the instructions below.

Sequence IVB Retroactive Registration Instructions:

- Test sponsors may only request retroactive Sequence IVB registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from May 31, 2019 through August 31, 2019.
- Only operationally valid Sequence IVB tests that started in calibrated stands on or after October 18, 2018 through May 31, 2019 are acceptable for retroactive registration.
- Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all Sequence IVB tests starting on or after May 31, 2019.

<u>NOTE</u>: ACC Code Bulletins for the appropriate Appendices in the ACC Code of Practice will be issued in the very near future where information is relevant to the Sequence IVB.
