Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence X

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence X engine test. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. This engine test should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM Sequence X Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence X engine test stands were calibrated on March 19 2016. Therefore PAPPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the Sequence X through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Retroactive registration will be accepted through the ACC Monitoring Agency according to the instructions below.

Sequence X Retroactive Registration Instructions:

- Test sponsors may only request retroactive Sequence X registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from April 2, 2018 through July 2, 2018.
- Only operationally valid Sequence X tests that started in calibrated stands on or after March 19, 2016 through April 2, 2018 are acceptable for retroactive registration.
- Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all Sequence X tests starting on or after April 2, 2018.

NOTE: ACC Code Bulletins for the appropriate Appendices in the ACC Code of Practice will be issued in the very near future where information is relevant to the Sequence X.
