

## **Product Approval Code of Practice Alert Bulletin**

Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence VIE

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence VIE engine tests. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. These engine test(s) should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM Sequence VI Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence VIE engine test stands were calibrated on August 10, 2016. Therefore PAPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the Sequence VIE through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Test sponsors are permitted to request retroactive registration for operationally valid Sequence VIE tests that started in calibrated stands on or after August 10, 2016, but before January 6, 2017. Note that test sponsors may only request retroactive Sequence VIE registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from August 10, 2016 through March 17, 2017. Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all Sequence VIE tests starting on or after January 6, 2017.
