Re:	Inclusion of the Sequence IIIG into Appendices H and I of the Product Approval Code of Practice – April 2005 Edition

The American Chemistry Council's (ACC) Minor Formulation Modification Work Group (MFMWG) has proposed to the Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) to include the Sequence IIIG into Appendices H and I. On April 20, 2005, the PAPTG approved the recommendation to include the Sequence IIIG into Appendices H and I.

Changes to Appendix H, Page H-2, include "The guidelines listed herein are applicable only to Sequences IIIF, **IIIG**, IVA, VG, VIB, and VIII engine tests".

Changes to Appendix I, Page I-1, include "2) The final commercial formulation must contain all minor formulation modifications made for base oil interchangeability testing. For the Sequences IIIF, **IIIG**, IVA, VG, VIB, and VIII engine tests in the Code, the total number of changes from the tested formulations...".
