Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence IX

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence IX engine test. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. This engine test should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM Sequence IX Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence IX engine test stands were calibrated on August 15, 2017. Therefore PAPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the Sequence IX through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Test sponsors are permitted to request retroactive registration for operationally valid Sequence IX tests that started in calibrated stands on or after August 15, 2017, but before November 1, 2017. Note that test sponsors may only request retroactive Sequence IX registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from November 1, 2017 through February 1, 2018. Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all Sequence IX tests starting on or after November 1, 2017.

<u>NOTE</u>: ACC Code Bulletins for the appropriate Appendices in the ACC Code of Practice will be issued in the very near future where information is relevant to the Sequence IX.
