Dear Speaker Pelosi and Leader McCarthy:

On behalf of the American Chemistry Council, I am writing to urge you to vote YES on H.R. 4996, the *Ocean Shipping Reform Act of* 2021 (OSRA21) when it comes up on the Suspension Calendar this week. As a result of the current supply chain disruptions, the chemical industry is increasingly concerned about the growing negative impact that unprecedented gridlock in freight transportation is having on their manufacturing operations.

Materials, innovations and technologies made possible by chemistry are used to make nearly all of the products we use and count on every day. The impact on our industry and the broader economy grows more profound as we continue to witness how the demand for both inputs to production and finished goods push our transportation supply chains past their breaking points.

The Ocean Shipping Reform Act of 2021 (H.R. 4996) would put in place common sense reforms to address long-standing issues in the maritime shipping industry, which have been further highlighted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite the significant changes and challenges in how goods are moved, the Shipping Act has not been updated in more than twenty years. The law needs to be updated to reflect 21st century global maritime trade. While we realize this legislation will not solve current supply chain disruption issues, it will go a long way to address some of the core issues.
