Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence VIF

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence VIF engine tests. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. These engine test(s) should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to correspondence with the ASTM Sequence VI Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence VIF engine test stands were calibrated on April 18, 2017. Therefore PAPTG reached consensus to retroactive registration for the Sequence VIF through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA). Test sponsors are permitted to request retroactive registration for operationally valid Sequence VIF tests that started in calibrated stands on or after April 18, 2017, but before August 15, 2017. Note that test sponsors may only request retroactive Sequence VIF registration with the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) from July 20, 2017 through October 20, 2017. Normal registration, as per the ACC Code of Practice, will be permitted for all Sequence VIF tests starting on or after August 15, 2017.
