Re: Retroactive Engine Test Registration of the Sequence IIIH, IIIHA and IIIHB

The American Chemistry Council (ACC) Product Approval Protocol Task Group (PAPTG) reached consensus to initiate retroactive registration of the Sequence IIIH, Sequence IIIHA and Sequence IIIHB engine tests. The current test registration fee of \$150 per registered test will apply. These engine test(s) should be appropriately displayed in all data summaries; including documents such as Candidate Data Packages (CDPs).

According to the open letter from the ASTM Sequence III Surveillance Panel Chair, Sequence IIIH, IIIHA and IIIHB engine test stands were calibrated on April 15, 2016. Therefore PAPTG reached consensus the retroactive registration date for candidate registration of the Sequence IIIH, IIIHA and IIIHB may commence through the ACC Monitoring Agency (ACC MA) on April 15, 2016.
